#### Carabinieri Corps, Carabinieri Biodiversity Department and

#### **130 State Nature Reserves**

- The Carabinieri Corps is one of Italy's police forces with general and public security jurisdiction. It deals with various areas including land, environment and forest protection
- The Carabinieri Biodiversity Department depends on the Environmental and agro-food Forestry Units Command (CUFA), which is a large unit of the Carabinieri Corps. In particular, CUFA is specialized in the environmental and forestry sectors (Cites, forest fires, control of mountain territories, forests, National Parks, State Nature Reserves, biodiversity conservation, environmental education)









The Carabinieri Biodiversity Department coordinates the activities of the 28 Biodiversity **Offices** present in almost all of Italy and 3 National **Biodiversity Center.** Biodiversity Offices manage 130 State Nature Reserves and other 19 State Nature Areas







Study and conservation of forest ecosystem biodiversity, monitoring of protected insects, role of deadwood in the forest ecosystem







The CNBF in Peri, like the same in Pieve S. Stefano, is a center of excellence on the study, production and conservation of forest reproductive material (seeds and seedlings) in order to give support to reforestation activities in Italy.

It manages the entire forest nursery supply chain, from collecting fruits to the production and supply of seeds and seedlings. Produces seed of native tree and shrub forest species.

#### **Activities:**

- Forest nursery activities
- Management of several new forests (tot 45 hectares)
- Molecular biology laboratory
- Seed quality testing Laboratory






