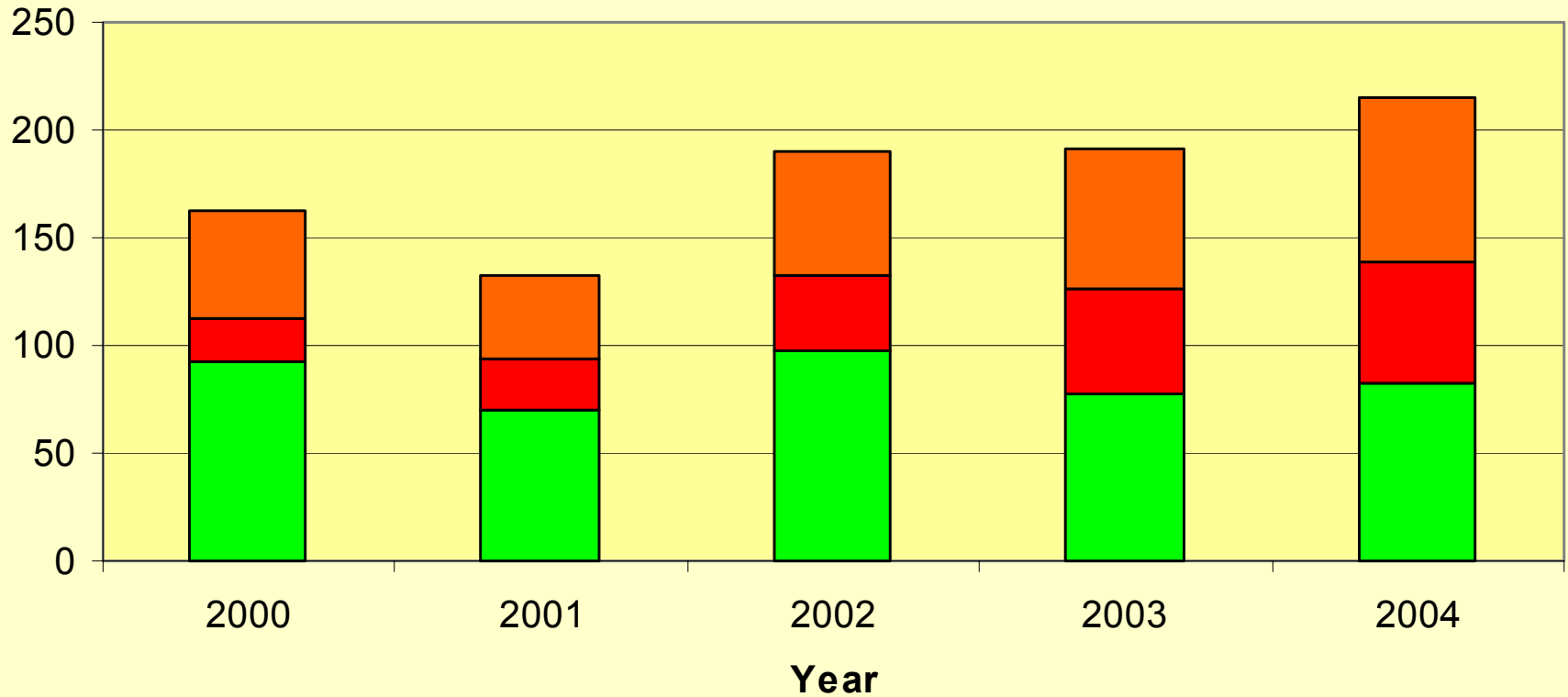

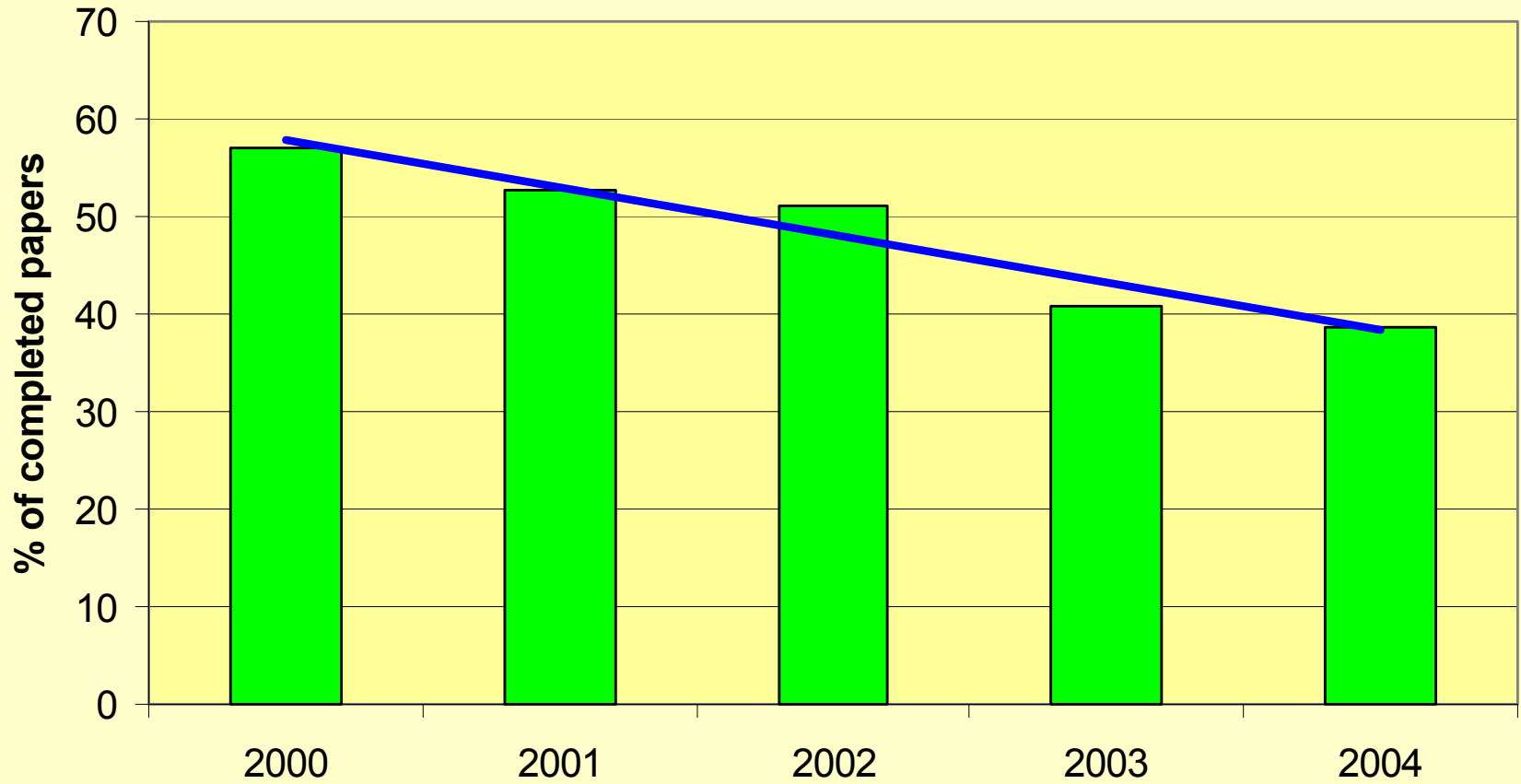

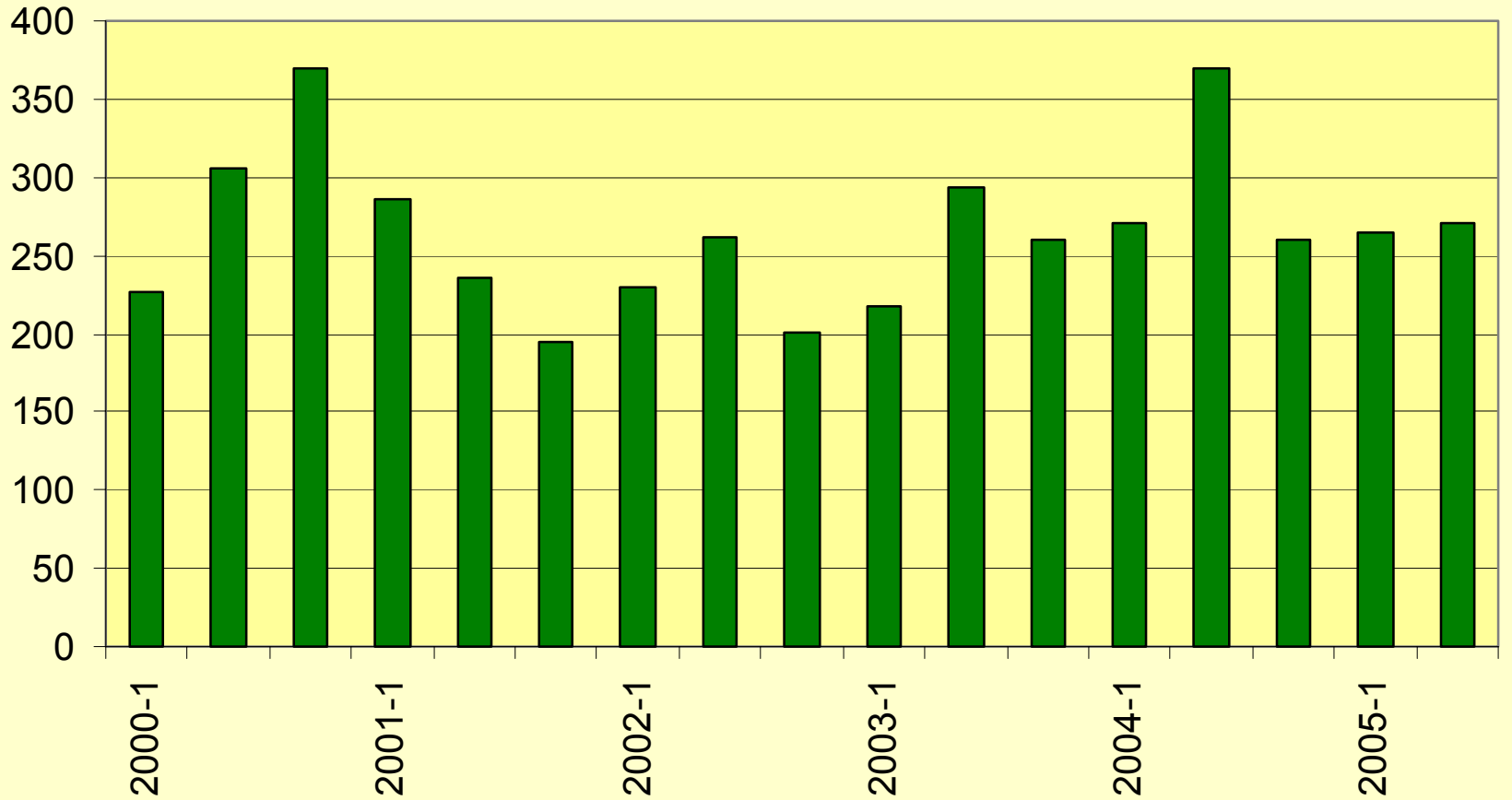

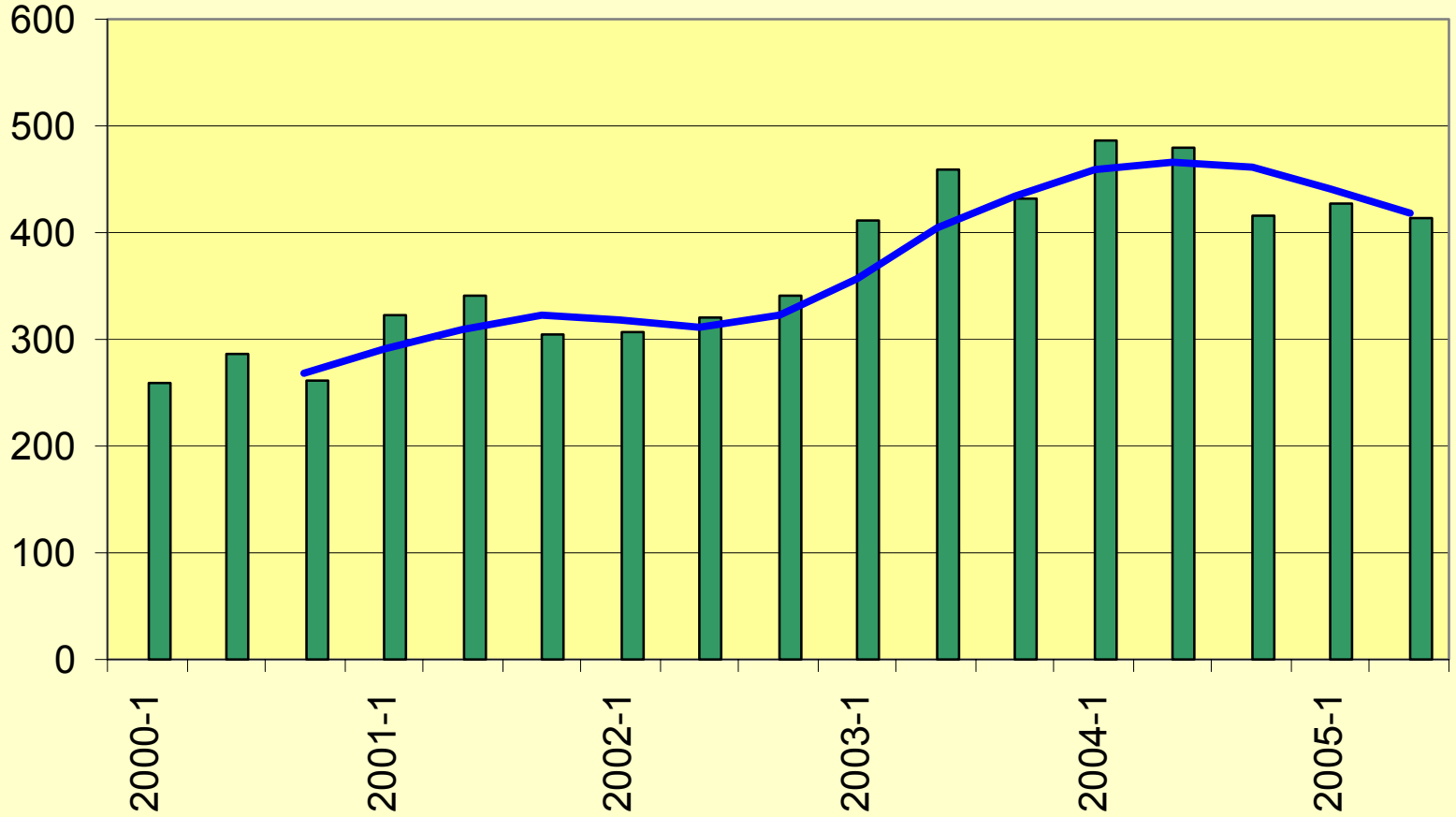
Accept percentage



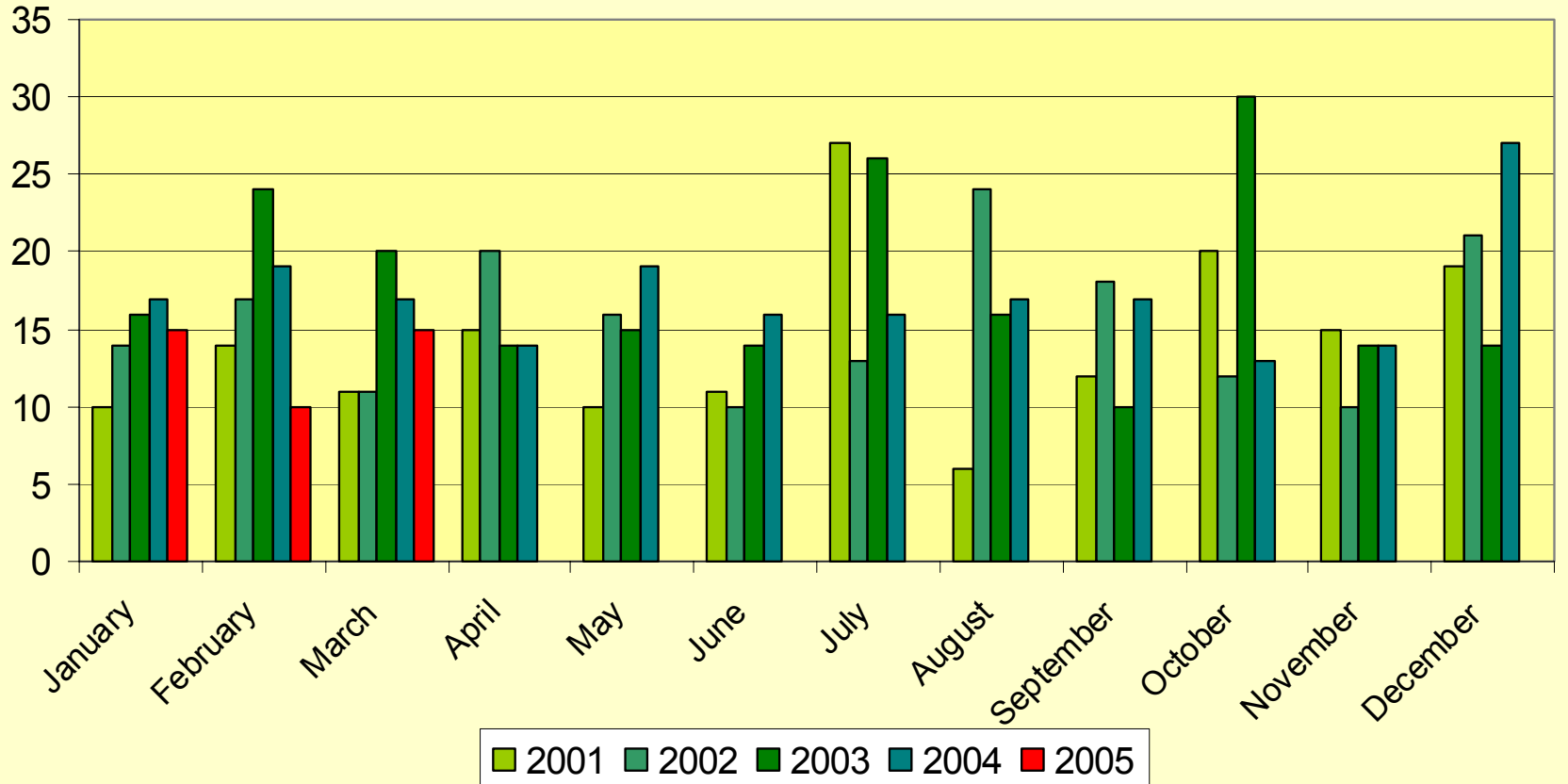
Pages per issue

New tasks 2004

- CD-Rom version
- Pre-publication abstracts on ISTA web
- E-mail submission
- E-mail revision/comments
- Shorter review times (8 weeks)
- Page charges (for papers accepted after 1. February 2005)

New tasks 2004

- CD-Rom version
- 228 out of 607 subscribers (ISTA members + 6)
- Cheaper than print
- Cheaper postage

New tasks 2004

- Pre-publication abstracts on ISTA web
 - Like many other journals...
 - Appreciated by authors

New tasks 2004

- E-mail submission
 - Faster communication
- E-mail revision/comments
 - Faster and more convenient for authors as well as editors
- Shorter review times (8 weeks)
 - Liked by all parties

New tasks 2004

- Page charges (for papers accepted after 1. February 2005)
 - ISTA members exempt (if one author is member)
 - Two withdrawals so far
 - Many spontaneous comments indicating "Yes of course"

- Access to single papers after payment
- Access to full papers for researchers from Third countries (FAO)?
- Access to old issues in ISTA web??
- Debate about cores issues

New tasks 2005 etc.

- Access to single papers after payment
 - Authors who are not subscribers might wish to buy a copy of one paper

New tasks 2005 etc.

- Debate about cores issues
 - Still too many accepted papers – could we reject more as 'not our focus'?
 - Germination of rare plants?
 - Fine tuning of germination conditions of species of moderate economical importance?
 - Papers on field performance?
