Fallopia convolvulus (L.)A.Love (Polygonaceae)

One seeded achene with or without perianth

General shape: trigonal with slightly concave sides, framed by curved, sharp ridges

Normal size: 3.0-4.5 L x 2.5-3.0 W x 2.5-3.0 D mm

Color: black

Texture: finely punctate, lustreless, the ridges are shiny. Often covered (entirely or partially) by the desiccated, smooth perianth.

Distinguishing features: the seed is widest in the middle.

Embryo: Embryo lies underneath one ridge and follows its curve. The nutritive storage tissue fills in the remaining interior space of the seed.
